Apples have a steady market, good demand
Grapes steady market, fairly good demand
Kiwifruit about steady—steady market, moderate
demand

Papaya about steady market, moderate demand *Wide range in quality and condition*

Pears steady market with good demand

Pineapples lower—about steady market, fairly light—moderate demand

Pomegranates have a steady market, fairly light demand with *wide range in quality*

Mangoes about steady market, moderate demand

VEGETABLES

Asparagus market for Jumbo is lower while Standard is higher and others are about steady, moderate demand

Beans about steady market, fairly light demand *Wide range in quality*

Broccoli market varies from about steady—higher, light supply, good demand *Wide range in quality and price*

Cabbage market ranges from lower—higher, moderate demand, *Variable quality*

Cauliflower higher market, light supply, demand
